1 Outline of Vaccinations

In Oshu, we are proceeding with vaccinations so that all citizens who wish to receive the vaccine can do so in line with the vaccine supplied by the nation.

Currently, the only vaccine used by Oshu is the one manufactured by Pfizer. This vaccine is intended for people aged 12 and older. Furthermore, if you are going to receive other vaccinations, please be careful to have an interval of 13 days or more.

First / Second Vaccinations

As the number of persons vaccinated in the city has exceeded 80%, we are reducing the scale in the future.

Vaccination Schedule from January

The first inoculation for new 12-year-olds will be the main focus.

- > Vaccination venues: Oshu City Mizusawa Hospital, Izutsu Clinic
- > Those between the ages of 12 and 15 can make reservations through the Call Center.
- ➤ Those aged 16 and older can make reservations through the Call Center or over the Internet.
- * If you are sleep deprived or hungry, you may feel sick after vaccination. Get in shape before receiving the vaccination.
- * If you wish to receive vaccination and have not made a reservation yet, please make a reservation as soon as possible.

Third Vaccinations

Booster shots (third vaccinations) have begun for those over 18 years old who have passed eight months since the conclusion of their second vaccination. We plan to send Vaccination Tickets to targeted individuals in the order from persons who are close to their time for vaccination.

If you have transferred to Oshu after your second vaccination and would like to receive the third vaccination, you need to apply for a Vaccination Ticket. (Some people may not be automatically sent Vaccination Tickets.)

2 Estimated Times for (Third) Vaccinations

In principle, you can receive a third vaccination eight months after your second vaccination, but this may change depending on vaccination policies and such as indicated by the nation.

The main side effects of the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines, currently approved in Japan, include pain at the site of inoculation, fatigue, chills, fever, and so on.

6 Request to Those Who Have Moved to Oshu

In order to receive a vaccination in Oshu, you must have a Vaccination Ticket issued by Oshu.

If you wish to receive a vaccination, please apply to be issued a Vaccination Ticket as follows.

In addition, if you received your first or second vaccination using Vaccination Tickets issued by a different municipality, your history of vaccinations may not automatically be received, meaning that your third Vaccination Ticket may be not sent. In this case as well, please apply to be issued a Vaccination Ticket.

- How to Apply
 - 1 Apply directly in person

Applications are accepted at City Hall and the various branches of City Hall. Vaccination Tickets can be issued on the same day.

 $\fine X$ Vaccination Tickets for third vaccinations cannot be issued on the same

day until system maintenance is completed. It will take about 10 days to be delivered by mail.

7 Vaccinations Other than from your Residence

In principle, the new coronavirus vaccine will be given in the municipality where vour Residence Certificate is issued.

However, if you are staying for a long period of time at a place other than that listed on your Residence Certificate for unavoidable reasons (such as work related transfers, students boarding in a remote location, pregnant women returning home to give birth, etc.), you can receive a vaccination after notifying the municipality wherein the medical institution providing vaccinations is located. Those who applied for the first or second vaccination also need to apply again for the booster (third) vaccination.

In addition, if any of the following unavoidable reasons apply to you, you do not have to notify the city.

① Persons hospitalized or institutionalized

- ② If a person with an underlying condition is vaccinated by their attending physician
- ③ If a vaccination is required at an established medical facility, such as when there is a high risk of side effects
- ④ If you receive a vaccination at home during a house call from a medical institution outside of the municipality
- 5 Persons who are victims of disaster
- 6 Detainees or persons being detained, and prisoners
- Persons who are vaccinated at "large-scale vaccination venues" set up by the national or prefectural government
- Persons who are vaccinated at their workplace (limited to those sponsored by the prefecture)

Notifications

By mail

Complete the necessary items on a "Notification for Vaccination for Persons not at Residence (New Coronavirus Disease)." Mail along with the Vaccination Tickets you currently have or a copy of something that can confirm your vaccination history to the following address. It will take about 10 days from the time of application to issue the Notification Certificate.
