# 4th Doses of COVID-19 Vaccines Are Starting

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> doses of COVID-19 vaccines will be rolled out. People age 60 and up, and those age 18-59 with chronic health conditions, are eligible. You can get your 4<sup>th</sup> dose 5 months after the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose; these vaccines are free of charge.

If you received your 3<sup>rd</sup> dose while living outside of Oshu, and moved in afterwards, you will have to submit an application separately. Please bring the receipt from your 3<sup>rd</sup> vaccination to city hall and complete the relevant procedures there.


