Important Notifications

★ The vaccination period set by the government for receiving the new coronavirus vaccine has been extended until March 31, 2023. For persons who would like to be vaccinated, please make a reservation soon.

*The first (1st and 2nd) vaccinations will be carried out during the above period, but those who wish to also receive a 3rd vaccination with the Omicron strain vaccine should first get vaccinated with the 1st and 2nd shot by the end of December 2022.

★ For persons over 60 years of age who have received a vaccination ticket, Oshu city has also allocated vaccination dates, so such persons should check for a postal notification as soon as possible.

Information for young people

With the spread of the new coronavirus among young people, it is advisable to get vaccinated as soon as possible with a vaccine that is available now!

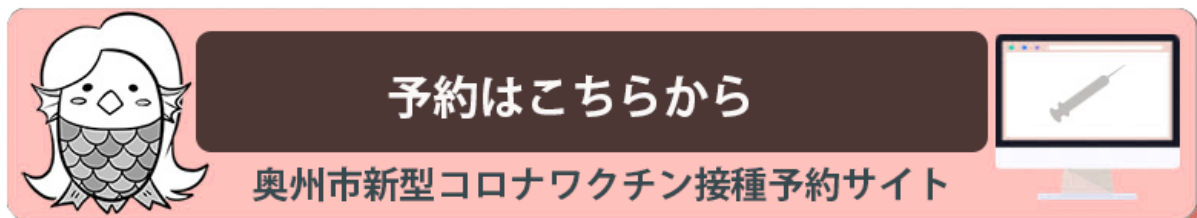
[Please be careful to not call the wrong phone number.]

There have been many cases of people calling the wrong number and contacting another entity. When making reservations please check the phone number carefully before making the call.

Since October, vaccinations against the Omicron strain have been provided. From November 2, 2022, the "Pfizer (for Omicron/BA4-5)" vaccine will be used.

【Note】 Until the reservation slot in December, the vaccine type on the reservation site is displayed as "Pfizer (Omicron/BA.1)", but all vaccinations provided for the 3rd shot after November 2nd will be "Pfizer (Omicron)" /For BA.4-5". (Please nonetheless select "Pfizer (for Omicron/BA.1)" when selecting the vaccination.)
