# Amendments to the Minimum Wage in Certain Industries

In Iwate, the minimum wage for certain industries has been changed.

Industry & amount: Iron & steel industries, wiring, other metal manufacturing: 908 yen

Optical equipment/lenses, clockwork: 886 yen

Electronic parts/devices/ circuitry, electronics, manufacture of information/communication devices: 877 yen

Retail automobiles: 903 yen

\* The prefectural minimum wage for retail, department stores, and general supermarkets is 854 yen.

### February 8th: City/Prefectural Tax Returns Start

Tax return filings for income made in 2022, and city/prefectural tax filings, begin on February 8<sup>th</sup>. If you are required to file but fail to do so, issuance of income certificates and proper valuations of National Health Insurance tax amount, the cost of Medical Insurance for the Latter-Stage Elderly, fees for childcare, etc. may become impossible. Please complete your filing by March 15<sup>th</sup>.

### Special Deal for Payers of National Pension by Bank Transfer

Major discounts are available through paying your national pension through bank transfer, rather than cash; if you pay with a credit card, you may be able to get points. Please set up a two-year, one-year, or half-year (first 6 months) payment schedule with your bank account or credit card by the end of February.
