Don't Forget: Light Motor Vehicle Taxes are Levied on April 1st

People who own motorcycles and light vehicles as of April 1st must pay taxes on them. Procedures are required within 15 days of changes such as new registration, getting rid of a vehicle, change of owner/address, or similar. Failure to do so will result in late fees. Also, name change procedures etc. are necessary for vehicles that are registered in the name of someone who has passed away. Please make sure not to forget.

Information on COVID-19

The Stance Towards Mask Wearing Has Changed

Starting March 13th, mask-wearing will essentially become a matter of personal judgement. The reevaluation of the stance towards mask-wearing in schools will go into effect starting April 1st. Please take care to respect others' personal choices, and do not compel others to wear or remove masks against their will.

Situations Where Masks Are Effective/Recommended

- When going to a medical facility for healthcare
- When visiting, or working in, a healthcare center, assisted living facility, or similar places, where many older adults or other high-risk populations live or are hospitalized
- When taking a bus, train, etc. during rush hour or otherwise crowded times (guidance for the time being)

When Showing Symptoms

If you have symptoms, test positive for COVID-19, or have a cohabiting family member who tests positive, avoid going out. If you must go out, avoid crowds and wear a mask.


Basic Infection Prevention Measures
