The office is open on extra hours and days off, to allow people to apply for, and get, a My Number card,

Extended hours: November 14th (Thurs) from 5:15PM – 8:00PM

Weekend hours (by appointment): November 23rd (Sat/holiday) and 24th (Sun), 9:00AM – noon

Details: Bring your driver's license or some form of personal ID. The applicant themselves should come to city hall for

the procedures. For minors under age 15, the minor needs to come to city hall, accompanied by a parent.

Health Insurance Cards Will Be Handled Differently from December 2^{nd}

Paper or plastic health insurance cards, which have been in use up until now, will be discontinued on December 2nd and will not be newly issued. When you get healthcare at a medical facility, please use your My Number card that's registered for use as a health insurance card (aka your Myna health insurance card.) Please contact the offices listed below for details.

How to use your health insurance card up until December 1st

If the term of validity is written on the card:

You can use the card until it expires; keep it and don't throw it away until then. However, be careful: if your health insurance card changes due to changing jobs, moving, or similar, you won't be able to use it anymore, even within the valid period. National Health Insurance cards that were issued or renewed by Oshu, and Medical Insurance Cards for the Latter-Stage Elderly, can be used until July 31st, 2025 (with some exceptions.)

If the term of validity is not written on the card:

You can keep using it for up to one year after December 2nd. For details, please contact your health insurance issuing organization.
