Request for Your Cooperation with the National Census

The National Census is held once every five years, and is the most important statistical survey conducted in Japan. All people and/or households (including foreign residents) are required to comply with this important survey.

Responses to the National Census can be made through the internet. You will receive the “User’s Guide to the 2020 Census Online” which will include a QR code. You can access the National Census online using this. Login using the login ID and access key provided. (It takes about 10 minutes.)

The personal information provided by you is strictly confidential. Those employed by the survey (surveyors, Oshu City employees, etc.) will adhere to an obligation to maintain confidentiality. The contents of your responses will never be divulged to a third party.

Results from this National Census are useful in various policies and programs that are indispensable for our government in order to improve everyone’s lifestyle environment and planning to prepare for disasters. By grasping the situation of foreigners living in Oshu in more detail, we can improve administrative services for foreigners and provide various information in multiple languages. Please cooperate by taking the National Census.
