#### **Information on COVID-19**

#### **To All Citizens**

Tension continues as multiple cluster infections have happened in Iwate. Please keep taking infection precautions and protect yourself, loved ones, this region, and our society.

#### ① Coming and going to places where infections are spreading

More opportunities for people to travel and gather together will come during the New Year's holiday, so we can expect that infection risks will be higher. Look into the infection situation in both your origin and your destination, and if infections are spreading, carefully consider if it's a good idea to go.

#### 2 Infection control basics

Basic tactics like wearing a mask and handwashing are very effective in preventing disease. Keep taking preventative measures at home, at work, and everywhere. Take particular care if you or someone in your household is elderly or has an underlying health condition.

- ► Wash hands, always wear a mask, coughing etiquette, ventilation, humidity control etc. ► Take your temperature and generally check in with your health every day ► Avoid close range conversations and raising your voice ► Avoid eating together and gathering in places that have the 3 C's (crowds, enclosed space, close conversations) ► If you're feeling unwell, ask a doctor about it over the phone
- ③ Infection prevention over the New Year

Take care to avoid congestion during travel, and stagger hatsumode shrine visits.

4 Act calmly and with consideration

Healthcare workers are working on the frontlines every day for citizens' health and livelihoods: please treat them and their families with gratitude and empathy. Maintain an attitude of kindness towards people who have been infected, their families, and their workplaces as well.

#### In Case of Symptoms, Reach Out

- If you have the following symptoms, please contact ① or ② below.
  - Difficulty breathing, extreme fatigue, high fever, or any other severe symptoms
  - Older adults or people with underlying health conditions who have a fever, cough, or other comparatively light cold-like symptoms
  - Anyone other than the above who has had a fever, cough, or other relatively light cold-like symptoms for 4 days or longer

#### ① Call your regular doctor's office

If your regular doctor's office is a testing and treatment center\*, you can get tested and treated there. If not, you will be referred to one.

- Prefecture-designated healthcare centers for testing and treatment of patients with fever or similar symptoms (list of centers not public.)
- ② If you don't have a regular doctor, or aren't sure who to call, contact the Diagnosis and Consultation Center You will be referred to a testing and treatment center.
- ♦ Diagnosis and Consultation Center (formerly Call Center for Returnees/People Who've Had Contact)

[For pregnant people] Just in case, if you have symptoms reach out for help as soon as possible.

[For caretakers of children] Call either the Diagnosis and Consultation Center or the child's regular pediatrician.
