#### **To All Citizens**

Compared to before, when multiple clusters were increasing at a rapid rate, COVID-19 cases within the prefecture have gone down. However, cases have been confirmed for several days in a row, so our city cannot be said to be safe. #### In Case of Symptoms, Reach Out

- If you have the following symptoms, please contact ① or ② below.
  - Difficulty breathing, extreme fatigue, high fever, or any other severe symptoms
  - Older adults or people with underlying health conditions who have a fever, cough, or other comparatively light cold-like symptoms
  - Anyone other than the above who has had a fever, cough, or other relatively light cold-like symptoms for 4 days or longer
- ① Call your regular doctor's office

If your regular doctor's office is a testing and treatment center\*, you can get tested and treated there. If not, you will be referred to one.

- Prefecture-designated healthcare centers for testing and treatment of patients with fever or similar symptoms (list of centers not public.)
- ② If you don't have a regular doctor, or aren't sure who to call, contact the Diagnosis and Consultation Center You will be referred to a testing and treatment center.
- Diagnosis and Consultation Center (formerly Call Center for Returnees/People Who've Had Contact)
