Vaccinations for the New Coronavirus

Receiving a Vaccination Ticket

The city is creating a system for inoculations based on priorities set by the national government so that inoculations can be performed promptly when the vaccine supply system is ready.

The following is information concerning those subject to inoculation, individual notifications, reservation methods, etc., looking toward inoculation of the elderly scheduled for April.

1. Outline of Inoculations

Regarding the vaccines to be supplied, we plan to proceed with vaccination in sequence according to the priority of vaccination set by the national government.

All residents who desire the new coronavirus vaccine* can do so. A Vaccination Ticket will be delivered to those persons in accordance with the priorities set by the national government.

*Currently, the only vaccine approved in Japan is manufactured by Pfizer, and this vaccine is intended for people 16 years of age or older. We will update this information when other vaccinations become available for those under the age of 16.

(1) Delivery Schedule for Vaccination Tickets

We will send Vaccination Tickets as shown below, in accordance with the priorities set by the national government. You can receive the vaccination in the order in which persons receive their Vaccination Tickets.

However, until the supply of vaccines stabilizes, you may have to wait for a certain period of time from the receipt of your Vaccination Ticket to the vaccination.

(2) Vaccination locations

As the number of vaccines available is limited for the time being, we will mail Vaccination Tickets according to priority as soon as vaccinations are ready. Carefully check the information sent to you.

(3) Cost of vaccination

The vaccination is free.

(4) How to make reservations

Reservations for vaccinations can be made by calling or faxing the call center. We also plan on providing online reservations.

2. Oshu City New Coronavirus Vaccination Call Center

(1) Date: April 1 (Thursday)

(2) Services provided: Inquiries related to vaccinations and reservations for vaccinations

*We will post information such as phone numbers, work hours, and when reservations start as it becomes available.

3. Schedule

April 1: Call Center opens

Beginning of April: Vaccination Tickets sent to elderly persons

April 19 and later: Vaccinations of elderly persons begin (beginning with residents of facilities for the elderly)

4. Side Effects of Vaccinations

It is reported in papers that the Pfizer vaccine currently approved in Japan caused pain at the inoculation site, headache, malaise, and muscle pain after vaccination.
