Vaccinations to Begin

Vaccination Tickets for those 65 and Older to be Sent

The city plans to proceed with vaccinations as shown in the table below, based on priorities for vaccinations established by the national government.

First, Vaccination Tickets will be sent to the elderly from the beginning of April.

As locations for receiving vaccinations are ready, you will be informed of vaccination dates, times, and locations. Please keep your Vaccination Ticket in a safe and secure location until then.

Vaccinations are scheduled to begin around mid-April, but this may change depending on the number of vaccines supplied and the national vaccination policy.

For people of other ages, Vaccination Tickets will be delivered in sequence depending on the status of vaccine supply.
