

Vaccinations for the New Coronavirus

Vaccinations to Begin

Vaccination Tickets for those 65 and Older to be Sent

The city plans to proceed with vaccinations as shown in the table below, based on priorities for vaccinations established by the national government.

First, Vaccination Tickets will be sent to the elderly from the beginning of April.

As locations for receiving vaccinations are ready, you will be informed of vaccination dates, times, and locations. Please keep your Vaccination Ticket in a safe and secure location until then.

Vaccinations are scheduled to begin around mid-April, but this may change depending on the number of vaccines supplied and the national vaccination policy.

For people of other ages, Vaccination Tickets will be delivered in sequence depending on the status of vaccine supply.

(Note) The Pfizer vaccine is approved only for persons 16 years old and older. We will update this information about other vaccines for those under the age of 16 as information becomes available from the national government.

Call Center to be Established

The city will establish a special call center on April 1 for questions and inquiries from residents regarding the vaccination against the new Coronavirus.

In addition, the call center will make reservations for vaccinations when locations for vaccinations are prepared.

Local government officials will not demand money for vaccinations. If someone calls you claiming to be an employee of a public institution asks you for money or in any other way seems suspicious, hang up.
