Tax Day for Light Motor Vehicles is April 1st

Owners of motorcycles and light vehicles must pay taxes on them by April 1st. If the registration, owner, or address on the vehicle has changed, please do the necessary procedures within 15 days (or, if you get rid of a vehicle, within 30 days.) Late fees are possible if you delay.

- Procedures are also required in the event of a vehicle owner's death.
