

New Coronavirus Vaccinations

Persons Who Can Make Reservations and Times of Reservations

It is expected that there will be a flood of applications when we start accepting reservations.

In order to reduce congestion, we will accept reservations at different start times depending on age. If you wish to receive the vaccination, check the following starting dates and make a reservation.

Reservations for vaccinations are not yet being accepted.

In order to avoid congestion in reservations, we ask for your cooperation in making reservations in the following stages.

From May 17 (Monday) 9:00am: Persons aged 80 and over

From May 24 (Monday) 9:00am: Persons aged 70 through 79

From May 31 (Monday) 9:00am: Persons aged 65 through 69

- Vaccinations are voluntary. You can make reservations for two vaccinations at a time.
- It is expected that making a reservation will be difficult in the beginning. We will take the time to ensure that everyone who wants to receive a vaccination can do so.
- Please wait for the period of your reservation. Take measures against infections until the day of your vaccination.

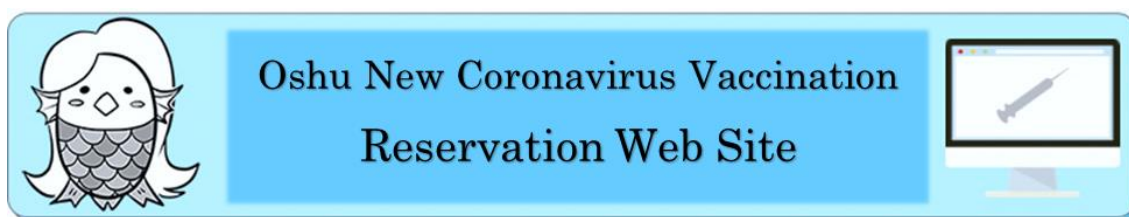

Receiving a Vaccination Ticket

The city is constructing a system for vaccinations based on priorities for vaccinations set by the national government so that vaccinations can be performed promptly when the vaccine supply system is ready.

We will inform you concerning the latest information that is available.

1 Outline of Vaccinations

Regarding the vaccines to be supplied, we plan to proceed with vaccinations in sequence according to the priorities for vaccinations set by the national government.

Supplies of the New Coronavirus vaccine and locations where vaccinations will

be available are being added one by one. It is expected that all citizens* who desire to be vaccinated will be. A Vaccination Ticket will be delivered to persons in accordance with the priorities set by the national government.

* Currently, the only vaccine approved in Japan is manufactured by Pfizer, and this vaccine is intended for people 16 years of age or older. We will update this information when other vaccinations become available for those under the age of 16.

(1) Delivery Schedule for Vaccination Tickets

We will send Vaccination Tickets at different times as shown below in accordance with the priorities set by the national government.

※ 1 In order to avoid congestion in reservations, we ask that they be made in stages. We ask cooperation from persons aged 65 to 69 to start making reservations from May 31.

(2) Vaccination venues

For the time being, supplies of the vaccine are limited. We will mail Vaccination Tickets in accordance with priorities as soon as vaccinations are ready. Carefully check the information sent to you.

(3) Cost of Vaccinations

Vaccinations are free.

3 Schedule

May 17: Start accepting reservations for persons aged 80 and over

May 24: Start accepting reservations for persons aged 70 through 79

May 24: Start vaccinations of elderly

May 31: Start accepting reservations for persons aged 65 through 69

4 Side Effects of Vaccinations

It is reported in papers that the Pfizer vaccine currently approved in Japan caused pain at the inoculation site, headaches, fatigue, and muscle pain after vaccination.

5 Request to Those Who Have Moved to Oshu

You cannot receive a vaccination in Oshu using a Vaccination Ticket issued at your previous address. Therefore, if you have moved to Oshu and wish to receive a vaccination, submit the Vaccination Ticket that you received at your previous address.

If you have a Vaccination Ticket issued at your previous address, come to the Health Promotion Division (second floor of City Hall in Mizusawa) or to the Health and Citizens Welfare Group Desk at any of the branch offices of City Hall.

After collecting the Vaccination Ticket issued to your previous address, you will be sent a new Vaccination Ticket by mail in about two weeks.

6 Vaccinations Other than from your Residence

In principle, the new coronavirus vaccine will be given to those whose address is on the Residence Certificate.

However, if you are staying for a long period of time at a place other than that listed on your Residence Certificate for unavoidable reasons (such as work related transfers, students boarding in a remote location, pregnant women returning home to give birth, etc.), you can receive the vaccination after notifying the municipality wherein the medical institution providing vaccinations is located.

In addition, if any of the following unavoidable reasons apply to you, you do not have to notify the city.

- ① Persons hospitalized or institutionalized
- ② If a person with an underlying condition is vaccinated by an attending physician
- ③ If a vaccination is required at an established medical facility, such as when

there is a high risk of side effects

- ④ If you receive a vaccination at home during a house call from a medical institution outside of the municipality
- ⑤ Persons who are victims of disaster
- ⑥ Detainees or persons being detained, and prisoners

- Notifications

- By mail

Complete the necessary items on a “Notification for Vaccination for Persons not at Residence (New Coronavirus Disease)” and mail it to the following address. It will take about 10 days from the time of application to issue the Notification Certificate.
