Notice About Vaccinations

Oshu postponed vaccine appointments for a month for those age 64 and under, since the national supply of vaccines was uncertain, but now appointments are gradually starting again.

Also, students and others who have put off exams and job hunting this year may receive priority status for vaccines, and vaccine tickets for the 12-15 age bracket will start to be sent out.

Priority Vaccines for Examinees and Job Seekers

Middle school and high school students who have put off exams or job hunting activities this year may be eligible for priority vaccination. This starts August 31st (Tues) for high schoolers; for middle schoolers, appointments will begin based on the vaccine supply situation.


Those who may qualify but are not currently middle or high school students may make an appointment via the Call Center after declaring their identity.

About COVID-19 Vaccine Certificates

The city will be issuing COVID-19 vaccine certificates to certify vaccination for those who have plans to travel abroad. This certificate may be used by the other country to determine easing of infection control measures, etc. when you arrive at your destination. Issuance is free of charge.
