1 Outline of Vaccinations

For Oshu, reservations will be taken in stages according to the following schedule so that all citizens* who wish to receive the vaccine can do so in line with the vaccine supplied by the nation

* Currently, the only vaccine used by Oshu is the one manufactured by Pfizer. This vaccine is intended for people aged 12 and older.

5 Side Effects of Vaccinations

The main side effects of the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines, currently approved in Japan, include pain at the site of inoculation, fatigue, chills and fever.

6 Request to Those Who Have Moved to Oshu

You cannot receive a vaccination in Oshu using a Vaccination Ticket issued at your previous address. Therefore, Oshu gives notification to those who have moved in every Tuesday and reissue Vaccination Tickets upon request.

In addition, reissuance of Vaccination Tickets can be requested by phone at any time.

7 Vaccinations Other than from your Residence

In principle, the new coronavirus vaccine will be given in the municipality where the Residence Certificate is issued.

However, if you are staying for a long period of time at a place other than that listed on your Residence Certificate for unavoidable reasons (such as work related transfers, students boarding in a remote location, pregnant women returning home to give birth, etc.), you can receive the vaccination after notifying the municipality wherein the medical institution providing vaccinations is located.

In addition, if any of the following unavoidable reasons apply to you, you do not have to notify the city.

- ① Persons hospitalized or institutionalized
- ② If a person with an underlying condition is vaccinated by their attending physician
- ③ If a vaccination is required at an established medical facility, such as when there is a high risk of side effects
- ④ If you receive a vaccination at home during a house call from a medical institution outside of the municipality
- ⑤ Persons who are victims of disaster
- 6 Detainees or persons being detained, and prisoners
- Persons who are vaccinated at "large-scale vaccination venues" set up by the national or prefectural government
- Persons who are vaccinated at the workplace (limited to those sponsored by the prefecture)
